If the page loads incorrectly or buttons do not respond, try clearing your browser cache and cookies, then refresh the page. Also, ensure that JavaScript is enabled in your browser settings, as PowerSchool relies on it for full functionality.

Displaying for Your Student

If you can log in successfully but see no grades or attendance data, do not panic. This usually means that teachers have not yet entered information for the current grading period, or your child's enrollment may not be fully processed. Check back after a few days, especially at the beginning of a new term. If the issue persists beyond a week, contact the school to confirm your child's records are linked to your account.

USING THE POWERSCHOOL MOBILE APP FOR ON-THE-GO ACCESS
